

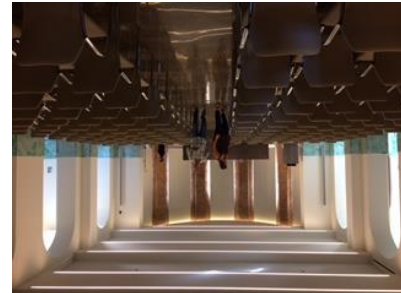
Synopsis of the Casa Diocesana de Espiritualidad

Built in 1923, the Casa Diocesana has been an oasis for the Catholic diocese of Málaga: a place to encounter God. As He did in the transfiguration with His disciples (Mark 9: 2-13), Jesus invites us to go up the mountain, be with him, dialogue with Him, pray and enjoy contemplative silence. The transfiguration shows us a path to discover more of Jesus, it's about a personal faith and love for Him, with the goal to accept Jesus as the Son of God, to lift the veil of humanity and contemplate His divine glory.



The realities of society and our human tendencies weigh heavy on our spirits and it is necessary to climb the mountain to meet with the risen Christ who alleviates our burdens, forgives our sins, allows us to contemplate His glory and fills us with the Spirit to return to the valley of our every day lives.

This beautiful location is a place for the faithful to rest from the craziness of everyday life and gather new strength in our bodies and souls. Our bodies will rest in the environment created and our souls will be renewed as we listen to His eternal Word, contemplate His transfiguration and renew our strength to walk our individual paths of life, where we face difficulties, misunderstandings, attacks and exhaustion. More than just a physical building, the Casa Diocesana aspires to be a spiritual atmosphere where people can come experience God.
